To Whom it May Concern:

Under the authority of the federal Clean Water Act and Pennsylvania's Clean Streams Law, the Chester County Conservation District has approved your request for a field change (**Initial phase plan for E&S Controls for the clean up only**) to your approved plan. The terms and conditions of your permit, including the expiration date, have not otherwise changed.

Should any measures proposed in this plan prove incapable of adequately removing sediment from on-site flows prior to discharge or prior to stabilization of the disturbed areas, or if accelerated erosion is caused downstream or downslope from the site, additional measures must be immediately implemented by the applicant/operator to eliminate any and all such problems.

The Chester County Conservation District requires notification at least 72 hours prior to the commencement of on-site earthmoving activities for a pre-construction meeting and will conduct periodic site inspections to determine compliance with Chapter 102 regulations.




