Important Information about the Township's Solid Waste Collection Disability Waiver

If a resident qualifies as a disabled person and does not live in a household in which an able-bodied person also resides, the disabled resident may apply for and receive exemption from using the hauler's provided refuse container. Qualifying persons must have a physical or mental impairment that substantially limits their ability to move a waste and/or recycling container (96-gallon or 65-gallon in size) to a curbside collection point. Existence of a physical or mental impairment must be confirmed by a Commonwealth of Pennsylvania licensed physician. The accommodation the Township can make is providing, free of charge, up to three stickers per week for a resident to place on trash bags and place the trash bags curbside. Recycling will need to be placed in clear, transparent plastic bags and placed curbside for collection. The Township's contracted trash collector will take back the refuse and recycling containers.

Residents with a temporary disability or impairment may apply for a temporary waiver. In this case, the Township will provide, free of charge, up to three stickers per week for the time period a Commonwealth of Pennsylvania licensed physician determines the resident will have the disability or impairment. If the resident's temporary disability or impairment continues beyond the original estimation, a new waiver request signed by a Commonwealth of Pennsylvania licensed physician will need to be resubmitted and additional stickers will be provided.
